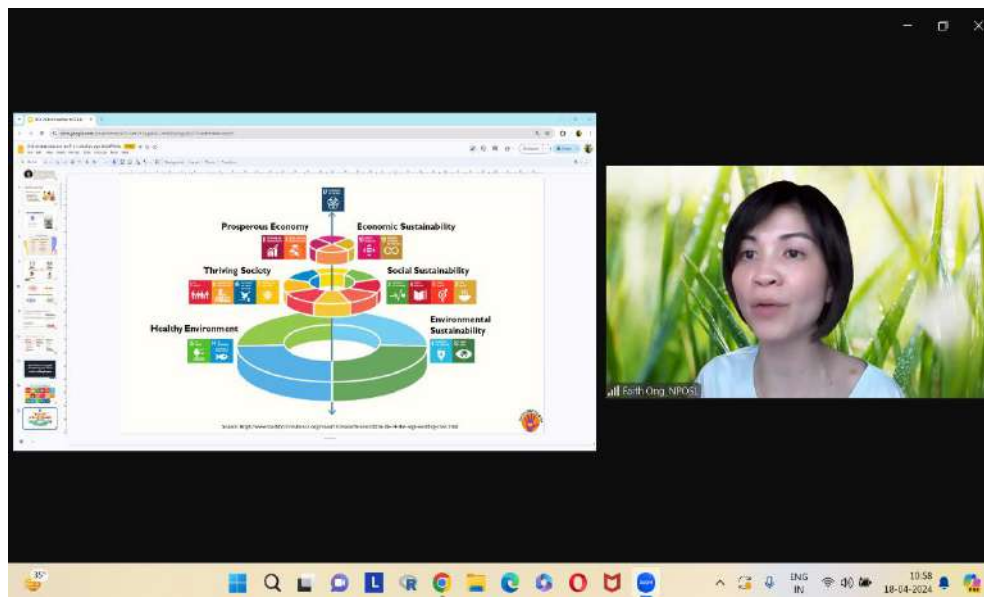
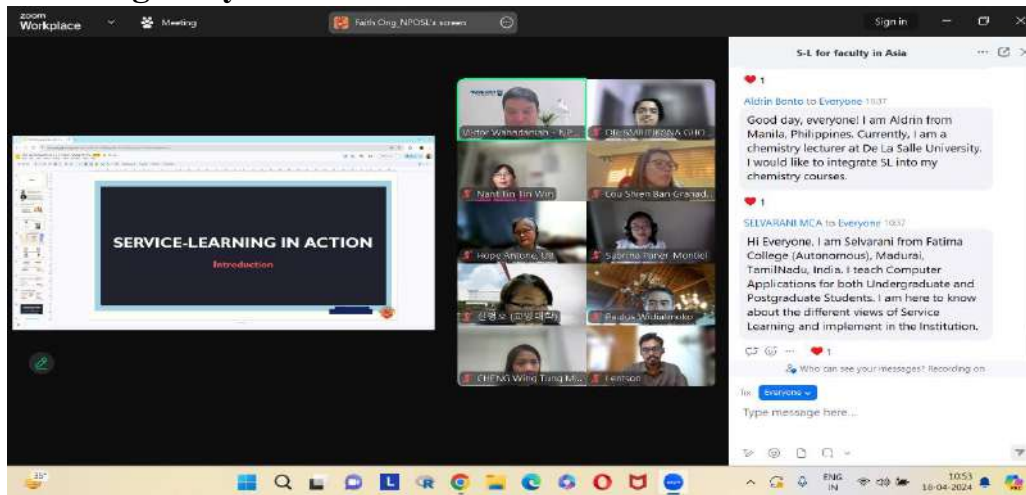
Objectives:
