

BRAHMABANDHAV UPADHYAY (11th February, 1861 - 27th October, 1907): Brahmabandhav Upadhyay was the adopted name of Bhabanicharan Bandyopadhyay, a graduate of the General Assembly's Institution and a classmate of Swami Vivekananda. He was the editor of the popular evening daily Sandhya and a great advocate of swadeshi. A contemporary of great men like Rabindranath Tagore and PC Ray, he was an ardent supporter of militant anti-imperialist struggle. When he converted to Catholicism later in his life taking up the title of Upadhya or preacher, he tried to bring together Hinduism and Christianity by practicing his own version of religious syncretism. A man with great intellectual gifts, the College takes pride in the belief that it contributed towards moulding it.
